To make a gift via transfer of stock or securities, please instruct your broker or commercial banker to transfer the shares to:

DONOR ADVISED FUND (DAF)

QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION (QCD) FROM IRA

Donors who are 70½ years and older can make a QCD from their IRA to an eligible nonprofit organization, including St. James Cathedral. By federal law, QCDs up to a maximum of \$108,000 per year can avoid taxation. To make a QCD from an IRA:

- ❖ Advise your IRA administrator of your intent to make a QCD to St. James Cathedral and specify the amount you wish to donate.
- ❖ Your IRA administrator will prepare a check for the QCD payable to St. James Cathedral to be sent to the cathedral office.
- Please inform Canon Robert Black to expect this check, noting the amount of the gift and the issuing entity.
